By signing below, I acknowledge the following:

1. I voluntarily choose to participate in the **Rally Rumble Volleyball Tournament** held at **Rally Pointe Volleyball Complex**.
2. I understand and accept all risks associated with this activity, whether known or unknown.
3. I hereby **release, waive, and discharge Rally Pointe Volleyball Complex, Volleyball Calgary Inc.**, their owners, operators, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and affiliates from any and all liability for injury, loss, or damage to my person or property that may result from participation in this event.
4. I certify that I am physically able to participate and have no medical conditions that would prevent safe involvement in volleyball activities.
5. I agree to follow all facility rules, event guidelines, and staff instructions.
6. I understand that this release is binding upon me, my heirs, executors, and assigns.

Rally Rumble Volleyball Tournament – Official Rules

1. Player Eligibility

- All participants **must be 16+**.
 - All players **must have a completed and signed waiver** before stepping onto the court. A parent or guardian must sign for any player under 18 and make a note on the waiver.
 - Any player participating in playoffs **must have played in at least one (1) round robin match**.
 - Teams found violating eligibility rules will be **immediately disqualified from the remainder of the tournament**.
 - Teams must have 2 females on the court **AT ALL TIMES, or the match will be forfeited**.

2. Game Format

- Matches follow the schedule provided; teams must be ready to play at their assigned court and time.
 - Sets are capped at 25 (15 for last set) and are based on time. **Games MUST stop and current points recorded when the buzzer goes.** (except for Championship and 3rd place games which will go until completed)
 - Teams are responsible for tracking their own score on sheets provided.
 - A 15 minute buffer/warm-up time is included between games.
 - Round robin tie breaker is determined by points +/- so all sets & points must be recorded.

3. Self-Officiating

- This is a **call-your-own-fouls** tournament. Players are expected to be honest and uphold the spirit of fair play.
 - Fouls include (but are not limited to): net contact, lifts, doubles, centre-line violations, illegal back-row attacks, and touches on blocks or hits.
 - If a player commits a fault, they must call it immediately.

4. Disputes & Conflict Resolution

- Teams are expected to resolve disagreements respectfully on the court.
 - If a dispute cannot be resolved between players, **RE-SERVE** the ball.
 - Teams may request a **tournament staff member** for rule clarification.
 - The tournament director's decision is **final**.

5. Sportsmanship Expectations

- Unsportsmanlike behaviour—including excessive arguing, harassment, or disrespect toward players or staff—will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the tournament.
 - Alcohol is permitted only in designated areas and must not interfere with play or safety.

6. Substitutions & Roster Changes

- Substitutions may occur freely between points or during timeouts.
- Roster changes may be made during round robin in case of injury or unforeseen circumstances with the **approval of the tournament director.**
- New players **MUST** sign a waiver.
- **No new players may be added once playoffs begin.**

7. Equipment & Safety

- Proper non-marking court shoes must be worn.
 - Jewelry should be removed or taped for safety based on player discretion.
 - If a ball enters another court, call “BALL!” immediately and stop play.
 - Any injuries should be reported to staff right away.

8. Penalties & Disqualification

Teams may be **disqualified without refund** for any of the following:

- Playing with an ineligible or unregistered player
- Using a player who has not completed a waiver
- Using a player in playoffs who did not participate in round robin play
- Refusing to follow tournament rules or staff instructions
- Repeated unsportsmanlike conduct

Disqualified teams will not be permitted to continue in any remaining matches.
